Dear Sen. Feinstein:

On behalf of the University of California, thank you for your leadership in introducing <u>S. 240</u>, legislation to rescind President Donald Trump's executive order that restricts individuals from certain countries from entering the U.S. The University is deeply troubled by the executive action and we support your efforts to ease the burden through passage of this legislation.

This issue is very concerning for the University of California. In fall 2016, UC's 10 campuses enrolled 495 graduate students and 40 undergraduate students from the countries included in the executive order. The executive order restricts the ability of our students, faculty, staff and other members of the UC community from being able to study, teach and conduct research—the fundamentals that make up the core of our mission as a public research institution.
